CHAPLAINCY

COMMUNITY ACTION (CAP) CITIZENSHIP & LEGISLATIVE

CAP Committee members work on identified key issues that are adopted by convention action.

COMMUNITY SERVICES DISASTER RELIEF

The Community Services Committee / Disaster Relief Committee works through public and private organizations to assure that members faced with problems in emergency situations get relief when needed.

CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS

Constitution and Bylaws Committee sets the stage for how the local will function.

CONSUMER AFFAIRS

The Consumer Affairs Committee monitors the social conscience and performance of companies in order to ensure members consume safe and honest products and services. This committee helps protect our union brothers and sisters by educating them on scams, unfair lending practices and other consumer pitfalls.
